Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's Letter of Intent of even number dated 19.11.99 and with reference to your Letter No.'Nil' dated 22.11.99 on the above mentioned subject, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Govt. to the establishment of a new medical college at Mahaboobnagar, Andhra Pradesh by SVS Educational Society, Hyderabad with annual intake of 100(hundered) student with prospective effect under Section 10(A) of IMC Act, 1956 as amended.

2. This permission of the Central Govt. for establishment of the college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The College shall not admit more than one batch of students against this Letter of permission. The college shall also apply to MCI for renewal of permission well before commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff, and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by M.C.I. norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.
