Basic laboratory investigations like Haemoglobin estimation, Blood glucose estimation etc. were done on the site. Minor ailments were treated with available medication and Nutritional supplements were given. Cases which required further investigations were referred for higher centres and SVS hospital. Notebooks were distributed to children.

Eye camps

Reflecting on the world report on vision and the need to make eye care reach those who are in dire we at svv hospital from the department of ophthalmology have made an effort in attending eye camps in remote villages and schools that does not have access to eye care services. We follow a screening and referral system wherein the population is screened for ocular conditions including cataracts, retinopathies and refractive errors. Patients above the age of 50 years are evaluated for cataracts & then advised for either manual SICS /phacoemulsification. We have successfully operated hundreds of patients with cataracts and followed them for

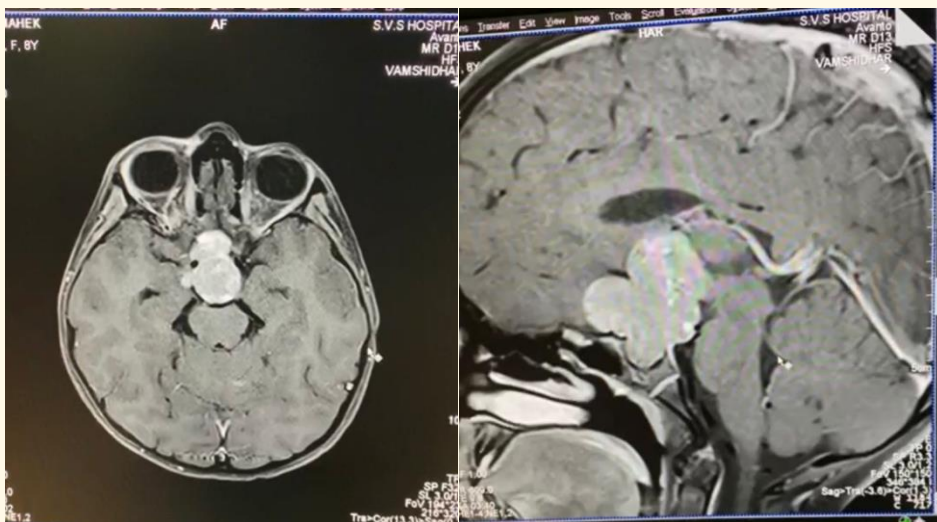
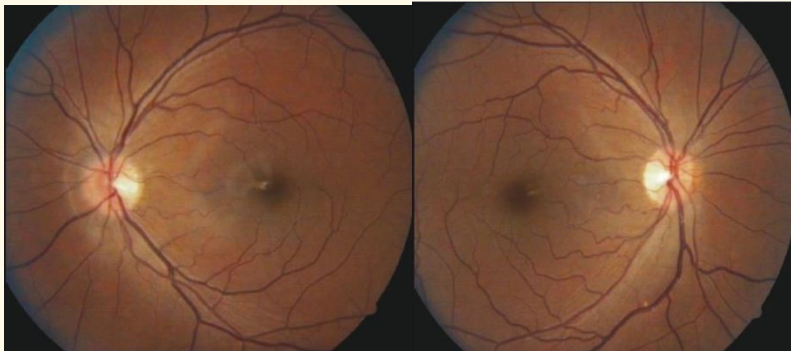

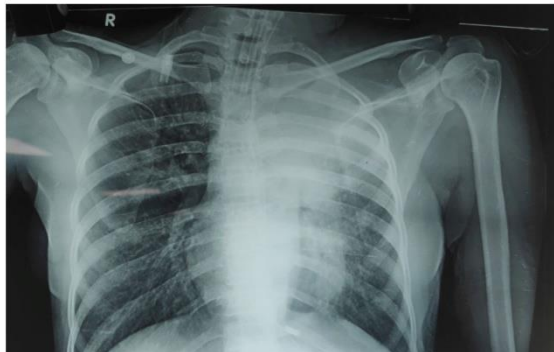
Acquired ptosis in a 8yr old female child secondary to pituitary macroadenoma

An 8yr old female child presented to ophthalmology OPD of SVS Medical College & Hospital, Mahabubnagar with the chief complaints of mild ptosis of RE since 1month & associated with fever, headache and diplopia for 2 days. On ocular examination BCVA in BE 6/9 & RE mild ptosis with hypotropia and adduction restriction were present. MRI revealed lobulated enhancing soft tissue lesion in sella and parasellar region extending into basifrontal region causing pressure over optic chiasm, 3rd ventricle and cavernous sinuses suggestive of pituitary macroadenoma. Hormonal essays revealed elevated prolactin, beta hcg levels and abnormal thyroid profile. On the basis of clinical examination and investigations a clinical diagnosis of pituitary macroadenoma was made. The case was referred to department of neurosurgery and advised transphenoidal resection under GA, after 2days of admission she had a respiratory arrest and could not be resuscitated. Pituitary adenoma is the most common cause of compressive optic neuropathy manifested as defects in visual fields, impaired VA and abnormal colour vision and extraocular movement restriction. Pituitary adenomas exhibit immense diversity in endocrine and ophthalmic manifestation. They offer better surgical outcome if diagnosed and treated early.



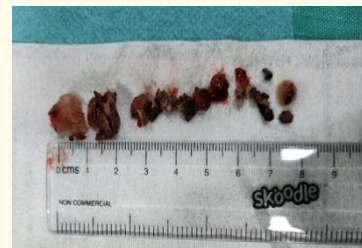
Migrating Foreign Body in the Airway

A 48-year female patient brought to op with complaints of cough fever and right sided chest pain for one week. Cough was productive in nature with no postural or diurnal variation. Fever high grade with chills and rigors. On examination, Pulse rate- 110/min, BP- 130/90mmHG; Temperature- 101F, RR- 21/min, SpO2- 94@RA. On Auscultation- right sided fine crepitations on Mammary/Infra axillary areas. CT chest shows right mainstem

bronchus obstruction with right middle lobe consolidation with air bronchogram. As the patient was not willing for admission, oral medication was prescribed. On worsening of symptoms and patient was drowsy, intubated outside and referred to our centre for further management. CT chest repeated again. CT



chest shows left main stem bronchus obstruction with total lung collapse. Bronchoscopy performed to rule out any foreign body or large mucous plug. Flexible optic bronchoscopy revealed foreign body at left mainstem bronchus. Despite trial with CRYO unable to retrieve because of fall in saturation. Rigid intubation done and foreign body removed with rigid forceps as piece meal. Patient extubated the next day.

Conclusion: Foreign body (FB) aspiration is an uncommon but potentially life-threatening event, majority of accidental aspiration events occur in children, adults represent up to 25% of cases. Adult FB aspiration can mimic more chronic diseases such as COPD, asthma, and obstructive pneumonia. When the diagnosis is not established immediately, retained FBs may lead to recurrent pneumonias, bronchiectasis, recurrent hemoptysis, pneumothorax, lung abscesses, pneumomediastinum, or other complications. Extraction of aspirated FBs should be undertaken as soon as possible to alleviate acute symptoms and prevent long term complications.

A RARE CASE OF ADENOIDCYSTIC CARCINOMA OF BREAST

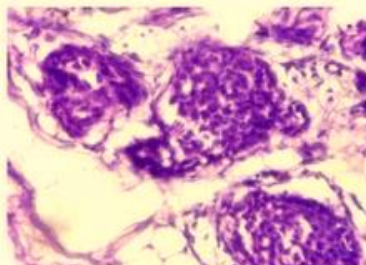
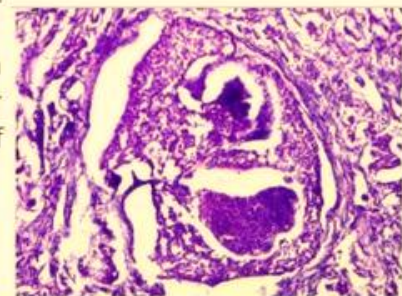

INTRODUCTION: Adenoid cystic carcinomas (ACCs) of the breast are defined as low-grade tumors with a histologic pattern that resembles that of primary ACCs of the salivary gland. ACCs of the breast reportedly give rise to few lymph node metastases or distant metastases and have a favorable prognosis ; immunohistochemically, they are classified as triple-negative breast cancer as they test negative for estrogen receptors (ERs), progesterone receptors (PgRs), and human epidermal growth factor receptor 2 (HER2). However, from the standpoint of gene expression, ACCs of the breast are considered different from basal-like subtypes of triple-negative breast cancer

CASE PRESENTATION: A 35 year old lady came to opd without any comorbid illness underwent unplanned excision of breast lump elsewhere and HPE was suggestive of Adenoid cystic carcinoma of breast. She was referred to us for further management. On further evaluation metastatic workup was normal. She underwent right modified radical mastectomy. HPE was suggestive of Adenoid cystic carcinoma, pT1 N2a, Grade 1, R0, LVE was present, ENE present. ER, PR, HER 2 Negative



DISCUSSION: Primary ACC of the breast occurs rarely, accounting for 0.058% of ACC cases. The most common area of onset is subareolar and in the vicinity of the areola (approx. 50%), and the tumor often appears as a spherical, mobile mass under palpation. The histological pattern of ACCs is of mixed growth of tumor cells that differentiate into glandular epithelial cells, basal cells, and myoepithelial cells, while producing abundant basement membrane-like material. The WHO classification identifies 2 subtypes of primary ACC of the salivary gland: a tubular/cribriform histological subtype in which tumor cells mainly form cribriform or tubular patterns, and a solid histological subtype mainly formed of solid tumor nests and cord-like patterns. The solid type is considered to be associated with greater malignancy than the tubular/cribriform type.



CONCLUSION: Rarely, metastatic carcinoma may also occurs in breast, in these, Adenoid cystic carcinoma is one of the entities, which is common in salivary glands, here by reporting a rare case of Adenoid cystic carcinoma of breast, a low grade tumour unlike other carcinomas of breast.

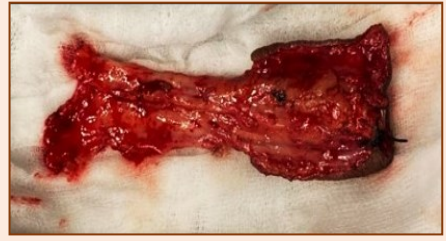

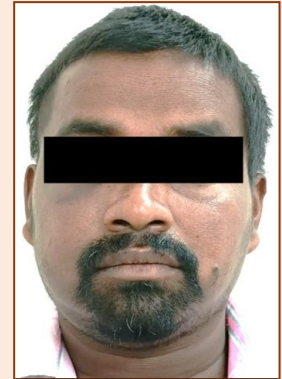
Cancer treated with wide local excision of the lesion and reconstructed with radial free flap

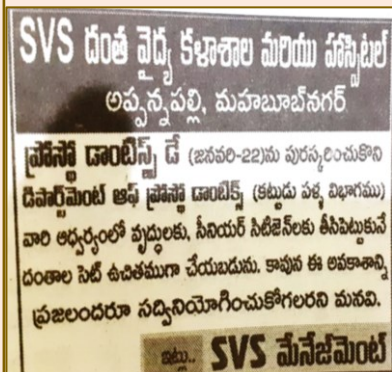
